



## Sunflower seed shell-less

### Feed Material

Our high-quality hulled sunflower seeds are a purely natural product for your feathered friends! These sunflower seeds are ideal for feeding wild birds all year round. The seeds are carefully shelled and are free from any additives or preservatives. So you can be sure that you are only offering your feathered friends the best.

What is particularly nice about the shell-less variety is that there is no waste to collect after feeding. Therefore, feeding on the balcony and terrace is also a good option.

Chickens also love to eat sunflower seeds. Whether they eat shelled or whole seeds is purely a matter of taste for chickens. Many chickens eat the seeds with the entire shell. Due to their high fat content, feeding them is highly recommended, especially in the fall and winter, as the seeds also contain many vitamins in addition to the fats. They are also an excellent source of additional protein.

### Recommended feeding:

**Recommendation for wild birds:** Our shelled sunflower seeds are suitable for feeding all year round! If you offer the food in bird houses or feeders, clean them regularly with hot water. In this way, you minimize the transmission and spread of pathogens. Make sure that the food cannot get soaked even in strong winds, snow and rain, otherwise it will spoil or freeze and the birds will no longer eat it. Did you know that robins, yellowhammers, dunnocks and blackbirds are so-called ground feeders? They don't like to go to the feeder, but like to pick up the seeds from the ground. If you have space in your garden, provide a ground feeder. Simply fill a wooden or plastic bowl with food and place it on the ground.

If you offer food, please also provide drinking water for the birds. Especially in winter, when natural water sources such as puddles or water in gutters are frozen, birds also need an extra bowl of water. However, there is no need for an expensive bird bath at the bird feeder; a flower pot saucer or an old soup plate are perfect as a watering place. The water should be changed regularly.

**Recommendation for chickens:** The amount of food for chickens depends on their number. 10 - 15 % of the usual feed can be replaced with it.

**Composition:** 100,0 % Sunflower seed, dehulled
